STUDENT CLASSIFICATION:

Junior High: ages 11-14 as of November 1, 2010

Senior High: ages 15-18 as of November 1, 2010

Collegiate: Students no older than 26 years of age as of November 1, 2010

ENTRANT CATEGORIES - Entrants may enter in the solo performance areas to include piano, guitar, organ, voice, strings, percussion, brass, woodwind instruments; and chamber music. Students may also enter in the category of composition.

*******IMPORTANT REMINDER:**

1. Students may enter either the WVMTA or the MTNA Competition, but may not enter both competitions on the same instrument.
2. Students may not enter the same repertoire that they have performed in any previous year within the same age category.
3. Teachers who enter students must register for the convention and must be available for monitoring, registration or other duties set forth by the chair.
4. Teachers should send in ONE check for all their students' entries combined.

REPERTOIRE INFORMATION: Please attach a repertoire list to this application, typewritten on a separate sheet of paper. Include the title, composer, performance timing and style classification. While there is no minimum time requirement, the maximum time limits are: 20 min. for jr./sr. high and 30 min. for collegiate. Student and teacher should work together to prepare a program, representing at least two different style periods (Baroque, Classical, Romantic, Impressionistic, Contemporary).
